A renowned humanitarian, Moira has been caring for sick and needy children and families her entire adult life. She is best known for her work bringing to Australia children with serious health problems that their own local doctors are unable to treat.

In 2016 Moira launched the *Moira Kelly Creating Hope Foundation*. She now manages a home in inner suburban Melbourne where children with serious illnesses and displaced women are housed and provided with medical care and support. Moira's focus is on those for whom others say there is no hope and she says of her work, "There's no saying 'no' to hope. Where there is a little bit of hope, there is a future."

Ultimately, Moira works to help children and families help themselves, so they can be as independent as possible and live full lives in the community.
